There are thousands of students in San Diego County who are eligible for up to \$1200 in Pandemic EBT 2.0 benefits that were issued in 2021, but have not activated or used it. As a result, the benefits are being reissused but families must call to claim the benefit.

To check your eligibility and claim your benefits, call the California P-EBT 2.0 Helpline at 1-800-887-8230 (MONDAY-FRIDAY, 6am-8pm) to request your 2.0 card. You can also visit the P-EBT website at www.ca.p-ebt.org and use the P-EBT Live Chat (Monday – Friday 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM) to request a new card.

You MUST call between BEFORE or by August 1st, 2023 and you must have the following information ready when you call:

- First and last name of the student/child you believe is eligible,
 - Date of birth of the student/child, and
- The address where your student/child lived at the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year. At least a partial address (street name) is required for your card to be reissued. If you can only remember part of the address, the Helpline staff may be able to find your record, otherwise a card cannot be reissued.
